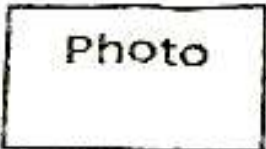

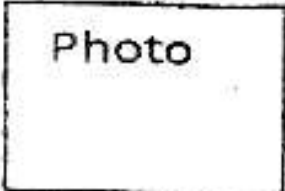

ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

4. Date of Birth Block (a) Candidate should be born between **01 AUGUST 1996 TO 30 NOVEMBER 1999** (both days inclusive) are eligible to appear in the recruitment rally.
(b) In case a Candidate clears the selection procedure then the upper age limit as on date of enrolment is 21 yrs.

5. Educational Qualification

(a) Passed Intermediate / 10+2/ Equivalent Examination in any stream/ Subjects approved by Central/State Education Boards, with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English.

OR

(b) Passed Two year Vocational Course recognised by Association of Indian Universities (CBSE/ Board of Vocational Higher Secondary Education Kerala) with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English in vocational course or in Intermediate /Matriculation, if English is not a subject in Vocational Course.

Note -1 : Boards recognised / affiliated by Council of Boards for School Education (COBSE) and Association of Indian Universities (AIU) will only be permitted.

Note -2 Exact aggregate percentage of marks before decimal as written in the Marks sheet of 10+2/ Intermediate/ equivalent OR calculated as per the rules of concerned Education Board will only be considered (For example, 49.9% should be taken as 49 % and not to be rounded off to 50%).

6. Domicile Requirement: To be eligible to appear in the rally at Industrial Training Institute (Near Indoor Stadium), Water Works Road, Shree Vihar, Puri- 752003 (Odisha) the candidates are required to satisfy the following conditions:

(a) The school / College/ Institute from where candidates have passed the qualifying examination should be within the geographical / administrative limits of specified Districts (as mentioned in Paragraph 3 above) of State of Odisha. If the name of the District is not mentioned with the name of Institution in the certificate / marks sheet of qualifying examination, the candidate are to produce 'Domicile Certificate' issued by Tehsildar/SDM/DM or any official authorised by the State Government of Odisha.

(b) Permanent Domicile of specified Districts (as mentioned in Paragraph 3 above) of State of Odisha who have passed the qualifying examination from anywhere in India. However, such candidates have to produce the 'Domicile Certificate' prior to commencement of examination from appropriate authority as given in sub paragraph 6(a) above.

(c) Sons of Serving Air Force Personnel, irrespective of their domicile status may be permitted to appear in the rally subject to submission of Son of serving Air Force Personnel (SOAFP) certificate (format available on AFNET CASB website) or PPO / Discharge Book / Service certificate issued from AFRO/DAV for sons of retired / deceased/ discharged Air Force personnel, in the following categories:

(i) Father/Mother is presently serving in any Air Force unit located in the specified Districts (as mentioned in Paragraph 3 above) of State of Odisha.

(ii) Ex-IAF personnel/families of deceased personnel who are residing in the specified Districts (as mentioned in Paragraph 3 above) of State of Odisha (on production of proof of minimum stay of one year along with Original and a photocopy of Discharge book, service certificate issued from AFRO/DAV for ward of retired / deceased/ discharged Air Force personnel).

7. MEDICAL STANDARDS (a) General Medical Standards for Group Y (Non - Technical) (Automobile Technician, GTI, IAF(P) only) Trades are as follows :- (i) **Chest** : Minimum range of expansion : 5cm (ii) **Weight** : Proportionate to height and age. (iii) **Corneal Surgery** (PRK/LASIK) is not acceptable. (iv) **Hearing**: Candidate should have normal hearing i.e. able to hear forced whisper from a distance of 6 meters with each ear separately. (v) **Dental**: Should have healthy gum, good set of teeth and minimum 14 dental points. (vi) **Health**: Candidate should be of normal anatomy without loss of any appendages. He should be free from all communicable diseases and skin ailments. Candidate must be physically and mentally FIT to perform duty in any part of the world, in any climate and terrain. (vii) **Body Tattoo** Permanent body tattoos on inner face of the fore arms (inside of elbow to the wrist), back dorsal part of hand / reserve side of palm & Tribal with tattoos which are as per custom & traditions of their tribes only are permitted. However right to decide on acceptability/ unacceptability of the individual rests with the selection centre. **Candidates with permanent body tattoos are to submit a photograph of the tattoo with details of size and type of the Tattoo.**

(b) **Height, Leg length, visual Standards and Colour Vision for Group 'Y' (Non-Technical) (Automobile Technician, GTI and IAF(P) only) trades** are as follows :-

8 Candidates discharged from the Indian Army / Indian Navy /any other Governmental Organisation are also eligible subject to their discharge with **NO ADVERSE ENTRIES** (original Discharge Certificates to be produced at rally venue on the day of testing). **Candidates discharged from Indian Air Force for any reason are not eligible to appear in the rally.**

9. Writing Material and documents required Candidates are to bring the following

- (a) HB Pencil, Eraser, Sharpener, Stapler, Gum tube and Black/Blue Ball Point Pen.
 (b) Seven un-attested recent (taken not before Jan 2016) passport size colour photographs (Front Portrait in light back ground without head gear except for Sikhs). The photograph is to be taken with candidate holding a black slate in front of his chest with his name & date of photograph taken, clearly written on it with white chalk in capital letters.
 (c) Original and four self attested photocopies of Matriculation Passing Certificate (required for Date of Birth verification). (d) Original and four self attested photocopies of Intermediate/10+2/Equivalent Examination Passing Certificate and Marks Sheets.
 (e) Original and four self attested photocopies of Domicile certificate or Original and four self attested photocopies of duly filled Son of Air Force Personnel (SOAFP) certificate (format available on AFNET CASB website) for sons of serving Air Force personnel or Original and four self attested photocopies of PPO / Discharge book / Service certificate issued from AFRO/DAV for sons of retired / deceased/ discharged Air Force personnel (or) Original and four self attested photocopies of Discharge certificate if applicable (as issued from Indian Army/ Indian Navy/ Government organisation). (f) NCC 'A', 'B' or 'C' Certificate (if applicable).

Note : Under no circumstances a candidate is permitted to appear in the rally without Original Educational Mark Sheets / Passing Certificate and documents mentioned above in paragraph 9(c) to (e). However, candidates with photocopies of Educational Mark Sheets/ Passing Certificates can be permitted to appear in the rally only on production of a certificate from College / School Principal certifying that educational certificates / mark sheets are deposited with College / School.

(g) **Consent Form** (as per the format given below) Candidates are to bring the "Consent Form" to the examination Venue and submit it before the Physical Fitness Test. Candidates below 18 years of age are to get the Consent form filled and signed by their parent/guardian. The candidates of 18 years of age and above can sign the consent form themselves.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

10. Tenure & Training : Enrolment is for an initial period of 20 years extendable up to the age of 57 years (subject to service conditions) Initially candidates will be sent to a Joint Basic Phase Training (JBPT) at Basic Training Institute, Belagavi (Karnataka). On successful completion of JBPT, candidates will be sent for trades training of specified durations. Training is however liable to be terminated at any time if the trainee fails to achieve the required standards in academics, profession, physical fitness and discipline or is found to be morally unfit. **AFTER SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF TRAINING, THE AIRMEN WILL BE DEPLOYED ON GROUND BASED JOBS AS PER THEIR ALLOTTED TRADES. ALLOTTED TRADE WILL NOT BE CHANGED ON CANDIDATE'S REQUEST/ANY GROUNDS.**

11. Pay & Allowances : During training, a stipend of Rs 11400/-per month will be paid. On completion of training the starting gross emoluments at the minimum of scale of pay including Grade pay, Military Service Pay (MSP) and Dearness Allowance (DA), will be Rs 20,000/-per month (Approximately) which, in subsequent years, may rise as per the career progression of the individual.

12. Other allowances such as Transport Allowance, Composite Personal Maintenance Allowance (CPMA), Leave Ration Allowance (LRA), Children Education Allowance, Family Planning allowance, House Rent Allowance(HRA) etc. are also admissible to airmen.

13. Perks :- Perks such as Ration, Clothing, Medical facilities, Accommodation, CSD (Canteen) facilities, Leave (60days Annual and 30 days Casual in a calendar year as a privilege), Recreational facilities, Transport for school going children and Leave Travel Concession (LTC) are also provided as per the existing rules. Not with standing with the above, Group Insurance Cover of Rs 25,00,000/- at a premium of Rs 1830/-per month, is covered for all airmen and facility of Group Housing Scheme is also extended. Other facilities by Air Force Wives Welfare Association (AFWWA) are also extended for family of airmen.

Note : The above pay & allowances are under revision.

14 Job Specification for Group 'Y' (Non Technical)

(a) Automobile Technician: As an Automobile Technician you will drive all types of light, medium and heavy automobiles, load carriers and specialist vehicles like cranes, towing tractors, fork lifters etc. subject to service exigencies. You will also carry out minor repairs, day to day maintenance and basic level servicing of common user vehicles and specialist vehicles in the Indian Air Force inventory.

(b) Ground Training Instructor: As a Ground Training Instructor, you will train personnel on drill, parade, handling of arms and physical exercise. You are also responsible for organizing and conducting all games and sports activities.

(c) Indian Air Force Police: As an Indian Air Force (Police) your responsibilities involve assuming police duties and investigation of offences. You are also in-charge of maintenance of security.

Note : Airmen will also have to undertake any other task as assigned by superior authorities.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

15. Verification of Eligibility : Original Certificates, Marks Sheets and other required applicable original/duly filed documents like NCC 'A', 'B' or 'C' certificate, Son of serving Air Force Personnel (SOAFP) certificate (or) PPO, Discharge book, Service Certificate issued from AFRO/DAV for Sons of retired/deceased /discharged Air Force personnel (or) Discharge Certificate (if discharged from Indian Army/ Indian Navy/Government organisation), Consent Form signed by parents if candidate below 18 years of age and passport size colour photographs will be required and scrutinized / verified at the examination venue prior to commencement of Written Test to ascertain the eligibility in prima facie. Detailed verification will be carried out later in respect of candidates who pass Written Test. Candidature of those who do not meet the laid down educational criteria is liable to be rejected during the verification of original certificates & marks sheet prior to conduct of Written Test and also during detailed verification on clearing the written test.

Note : The original Passing Certificate / Marks Sheet will not be retained by the Selection Centre. The same will be returned to the candidates on completion of detailed verification.

SEQUENCE OF EXAMINATION

16. Written Test:- Written Test will be objective type and question paper will be bilingual (English & Hindi), except English paper. Detailed procedure shall be explained before conduct of the examination. Duration of Written Test will be **45 minutes** and will comprise of English as per 10+2 CBSE Syllabus and Reasoning and General Awareness (RAGA). **CANDIDATES ARE TO QUALIFY IN EACH PAPER SEPARATELY.** Result of the Written Test will be declared on the same day.

17. Adaptability Test -1 All candidates who pass the Written Test will have to undertake Adaptability Test-1 as per policy in vogue.

18. Physical Fitness Test (PFT) :- All candidates who pass the Written Test and Adaptability Test-1 are to undergo Physical Fitness Test (PFT) on the same or the next day. PFT consists of a 1.6 Km run to be completed within 8 minutes. Candidates will also have to complete 20 squats followed by 10 push-ups and 10 sit-ups within the stipulated time to qualify in the Physical Fitness Test.

Note : Candidates are advised to bring their sports shoes and shorts.

19. Adaptability Test - 2 All candidates who pass the Written Test , Adaptability Test-1 & PFT will have to undertake Adaptability Test-2 as per policy in vogue.

20. Medical Examination :- Candidates who qualify in the Written Test , Adaptability Test-1, PFT and Adaptability Test-2 will be medically examined in the month of July 2016. Medical Examination will be conducted by Air Force Medical Team as per Indian Air Force Medical Standards and existing policy in vogue. Medical Examination would also include Baseline Investigation of :

Candidates declared Medically Unfit can avail the option for Appeal Medical Board (AMB) against their Unfitness by depositing Rs 40/- in a Government Treasury/RBI/SBI through Military Receivable Order (MRO). The application for AMB along with original copy of MRO, photocopy of Unfitness Certificate and Postal Stamp worth RS 25/- affixed on a self addressed envelope are to be submitted at MBC (Medical Board Centre), 4 Air Force Hospital, Kalaikunda (West Bengal) within three working days from the date of issue of Medical Unfitness Certificate.

Note- 1 : Candidates should bring latest prescription (one month validity) and spectacles for corrected vision, if used. The prescription must bear the signature, stamp and registration number of Eye Specialist.

Note - 2 Candidates are advised to get tartar & stains removed from their teeth before appearing for the Medical examination. Ears should be free of wax. Candidates should be prepared to travel / stay for the medical test for four to five days under their own arrangement. No TA/DA will be admissible.

21. Publishing of AISL:- The All India Selection List (AISL) list will be displayed at 9 Airmen Selection Centres, Near Rajdhani College, Baramunda, Bhubaneswar- 751003, Odisha on 31 October 2016. Copies of the Display List will be sent to District Magistrate of Puri (Odisha) (through Airmen Selection Centre) and will also be available at Central Airmen Selection Board website www.airmenselection.gov.in. The inclusion of names of the candidates in the AISL depends upon the performance of the candidates in the Rally. Inclusion of name in the All India Select List (AISL) does not guarantee automatic enrolment. Enrolment is strictly in order of merit from the AISL subject to Medical Fitness, Availability of Vacancies, not exceeding the age of 21 years on date of enrolment and meeting laid down criteria as and when called for enrolment. The validity of AISL will be 12 months from the date of display and will be applicable only for Intake No. 01/2017 & 02/2017.
